

Clare Welcome Center 2013 Exhibit Guide

The exhibit is scheduled from August 1st to September 30, 2013.

1. Artwork must have a Michigan theme.
2. 2D artwork will be collected in Midland, at a place to be decided. Volunteers will drive it to Clare and will install it. We will also return it to Midland at the end of the show.
3. There is a locked cabinet for 3D art. The 3D artist must deliver their art to Clare. It will not be picked up.
4. MAG cards must be filled out and attached to the art work. Blank cards will be available when you deliver your art.
5. The Welcome Center will not accept sales for us. The buyer will call you to make payment and delivery arrangements.
6. Members can sign up to exhibit 2 pieces of 2D art.

1. Include your outside frame dimensions for each piece, title, media, and phone number in your email.
2. Send a suggestion for the name of the exhibit.

We need to leave a list of art work at the welcome center desk .
We will install the exhibit on July 31st.



There are 8 sections across the exhibit span, with room for 16 pieces across the top row, 8 on each side and the same number of pieces for the bottom row.

Frames must be measured from outside edge to outside edge.

TOP ROW:

In order to make the art work fit the span the acceptable maximum frame size for the top row is 23" wide and 18" tall.

Pieces smaller than 23" wide will fit but we cannot accept anything taller than 18" tall.

BOTTOM ROW:

The maximum frame size is 18" wide and 17" tall. Smaller pieces will fit and be accepted.

Any frames with outside dimensions that are larger than the specified dimensions listed here cannot be hung in this exhibit. They just won't fit the space.

Frames must be measured from outside edge to outside edge.

The wire must be adjusted to hook 3 inches down from the top of the frame.

This will keep everything level across the top.

Adjust your wires before you deliver your art work.

The bottom row pieces must be wired the same way as the top pieces.



There are no specific guidelines for 3D art. We will have the use of the same cabinet we have been given in the past. It has two shelves and is locked.
